Nottingham Harmonic Choir

Since its foundation in 1856, the Nottingham Harmonic Choir, Nottingham's civic chorus, has established itself as one of the leading provincial choruses in Britain. In its early years the names of Charles Hallé and Sir Arthur Sullivan were among those associated with the chorus. At the beginning of the twentieth century its principal conductor was Henry Wood, later to become Sir Henry Wood, conductor of the first Promenade Concerts. More recently the Society has been privileged to be directed on several occasions by Laszlo Heltay, Richard Hickox, Sir Charles Groves and Sir David Willcocks.

Music Director RICHARD LAING

In April 2009 the young and dynamic Richard Laing was appointed our Music Director, and led us successfully through a **Drive Time Concert** with the Hallé Orchestra and a concert with the National Childrens Orchestra. More recently the choir again joined the Hallé - this time to perform Prokofiev's Alexander Nevski - to critical acclaim.
