The opera will première at Lakeside Arts, University of Nottingham on 2 April, 2022. **We are looking for 12 singers to take part in the Dementia Carers Chorus.** Those selected will need to be available for rehearsals in Nottingham from 21st to 31st March. In addition, there will be 10 hours of pre-production practice. Chorus members will be paid at the hourly wage for home carers.
