Nottingham Harmonic Choir

Since its foundation in 1856, the Nottingham Harmonic Choir, Nottingham's civic chorus, has established itself as one of the leading provincial choruses in Britain. In its early years the names of Charles Hallé and Sir Arthur Sullivan were among those associated with the chorus. At the beginning of the twentieth century its principal conductor was Henry Wood, later to become Sir Henry Wood, conductor of the first Promenade Concerts. More recently the Society has been privileged to be directed on several occasions by Laszlo Heltay, Richard Hickox, Sir Charles Groves, Sir David Willcocks and Sir Mark Elder.

In April 2009 Richard Laing was appointed as Music Director. He has led the choir through five widely acclaimed seasons, increasing our collaboration with Nottingham Classics resulting in several concerts with the Hallé, sinfonia ViVa and other internationally acclaimed orchestras.
