If you wish to practise your part beforehand, you can download MIDI sound files for the music from websites such as: www.learnchoralmusic.co.uk; www.johnfletchermusic.org; www.cpdl.org; www.prestomusic.com . Also, you may find 'ChordPerfect' especially helpful as it includes a professional singer who sings the words for your part. The ChordPerfect website contains most major works that are no longer in copyright: https://www.chordperfect.com/. Alternatively, you can buy a CD of your part from Choraline, www.choraline.com or use the Choraline 'app' to purchase and download music. The speed may be slowed down using Windows media player by 'right clicking' on the window and selecting 'Enhancements' and then 'Play Speed Settings'. Vocal scores may often be borrowed from your County Library store, and they can send it to your local library to pick up. The host choir may lend to you in advance (deposit may be needed), or try your local music shop. To research other 'Come and Sing' days/events/workshops, try googling or going to the website of a specific choir or visit British Choirs on the Net, www.choirs.org.uk/ .
